

The Florida Clean Indoor Act

The purpose of the **Florida Clean Indoor Act (FCIAA)** is to protect people from the health hazards of secondhand tobacco smoke and to implement the Florida health initiative in section 20, Article X of the State Constitution. However, the intent of this legislation is not to inhibit, or otherwise obstruct, medical or scientific research or smoking cessation programs approved by the Department of Health.

- Child/Adult Care Center
- Convenient Shop
- Beauty/Barber Shop
- Public Library
- Auditorium/ Theatre
