

2011 / 2012 Flu Season Information

The Seasonal Flu vaccine is available beginning October 5, 2011. This year's vaccine is prepared for the viruses expected to be active this season. These include: H1N1, H3N2 and B/Brisbane like Flu virus. Only one dose is required for adults each year.

The Pneumonia vaccination is one dose given at age 65 or older. A booster may be recommended for certain high-risk individuals after five years. Check with your physician! No prescription is necessary if you are age 65 or older, and this is your first Pneumonia vaccination. Pneumonia vaccinations may also be given without prescription to those with respiratory or other health issues listed on our website.

This year we are offering a [High-dose Flu](#) vaccine to our 65 years of age and older population. Please check our website for more information on the high-dose Flu vaccine.

Flu shots are free for those on Medicare Part B and Medicare Advantage Plans. Please bring your card with you. We are unable to bill Medicare HMO's.

If you have health insurance, please bring your health insurance card and photo ID. We may be able to bill your insurance for services. The charge for persons paying for services is:

- \$30 for Flu
- \$50 for High-dose Flu
- \$70 for Pneumonia
