



# Pre-Kindergarten 2010- 2011

## NO SHOTS, NO SCHOOL

### PHYSICAL EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

At the time of initial enrollment or registration, students entering a Florida school for the first time must provide:

1. A "valid" physical examination that has been completed within the **prior twelve months**.
  - a. Students who cannot provide proof of a valid physical examination must be excluded until they can provide the necessary information required on the Florida form DOH 3040.
  - b. An appointment card from a local physician or clinic showing that a physical examination is scheduled to be completed at a later date is **not acceptable**.
2. Physical examinations are available from your local physician or health care provider, walk-in clinics and urgent care centers. A list of clinics and pediatricians is available from your child's school or by calling 377-0514.
3. For Head Start only – Physical evaluation must include a current blood hemoglobin level.

<b>4 DTP/DTaP –</b>	Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis
<b>3 Hib-</b>	\H. influenzae
<b>3,4. or 5 doses of Polio-</b>	Number depends on child's immunization history
<b>1 MMR –</b>	Measles, Mumps, Rubella
<b>3 Hep B –</b>	Hepatitis B
<b>1 Varicella –</b>	Chickenpox
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Either 1 varicella vaccination (chicken pox), or</li> <li>• Documentation by a healthcare provider that the child has had the chicken pox illness</li> </ul>

### Remember

**All children must have a fully-completed blue Florida Certificate of Immunization Form DOH 680 at the time of registration. Bring your child's immunization records with you to the immunization provider to help determine what immunizations might be needed**

# Elementary School School Entry Health Requirements 2010-2011

- 5 DTP/DTaP**- Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis  
**4 or 5 Polio** – Number depends on child's immunization history  
**2 MMR** – Measles, Mumps, Rubella  
**3 Hep B** – Hepatitis B  
**2 Varicella** - Chickenpox
- Either 2 varicella vaccinations (chickenpox), or
  - Documentation by a healthcare provider that the child has had the chickenpox illness

#### Grades 1 and 2

- 5 DTP/DTaP** – Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis  
**4 Polio**  
**2 MMR** – Measles, Mumps, Rubella  
**3 Hep B** – Hepatitis B  
**2 Varicella** - Chickenpox
- Either 2 varicella vaccinations (chickenpox), or
  - Documentation by a healthcare provider that the child has had the chickenpox illness

#### Grades 3 through 6

- 5 DTP/DTaP** – Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis  
**4 Polio**  
**2 MMR** – Measles, Mumps, Rubella  
**3 Hep B** – Hepatitis B  
**1 Varicella** - Chickenpox
- Either 1 varicella vaccination (chickenpox), or
  - Documentation by a healthcare provider that the child has had the chickenpox illness

# Sixth Grade Parents

Don't let your child be the only one who can't start the first day of 7<sup>th</sup> grade!!

Before your child(ren) can begin the 7<sup>th</sup> grade, he/she must have documentation of having received the following immunizations:

- Tdap booster (Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) or
- A Temporary Exemption (Form 680, Part B) if Td vaccine received in the last 2 years

## IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2010-2011 GRADE 7

- 5 Diphtheria – Tetanus – Pertussis (DTP/DTaP)
- 4 Polio
- 2 Measles – Mumps – Rubella (MMR)
- 3 Hepatitis B (Hep B)
- 1 Chickenpox - Varicella
- 1 Tdap, Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis booster OR A Temporary Exemption (Form 680, Part B) if Td vaccine received in the last 2 years

We encourage all parents to have your child(ren) seen by a private physician or health care provider in the community prior to the busy summer season to receive the required immunizations. Private physicians and clinics charge according to their established fees.

Vaccines required for children are available free of charge from all Collier County Health Department facilities. Remember, you must bring your child's immunization records with you to help determine what immunizations are required and to provide the information necessary to fill out the blue Florida Certificate of Immunization Form DOH 680.

- 4 Polio**
- 2 MMR** – Measles, Mumps, Rubella
- 3 Hep B** – Hepatitis B
- 1 Varicella** - Chickenpox
  - Either 1 varicella vaccination (chicken pox), or
  - Documentation by a healthcare provider that the child has had the disease

#### Grades 7 and 8

- 5 DTP/DTaP** – Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis
- 4 Polio**
- 2 MMR** – Measles, Mumps, Rubella
- 3 Hep B** – Hepatitis B
- 1 Varicella** - Chicken pox
  - Either 1 varicella vaccination (chicken pox), or medical documentation of the disease
- 1Tdap** - Tetanus-diphtheria, pertussis booster or a temp, exemption if a **Td booster** received within the last 2 years

- 2 or 3 Hep B** – Hepatitis B
- 1 Td or Tdap Booster** –
  - Received after age 7
